

Dr. Olesya Fomenko is an economist at WCRI. She is currently working on a number of studies examining different factors contributing to claim-shifting to workers' compensation from group health. She is one of the lead authors of the studies comparing workers' compensation and group health prices paid for professional medical services and payments for outpatient facility services. Dr. Fomenko is also involved in the designing and updating of a series of studies analyzing prices paid in workers' compensation for common professional and hospital outpatient services. She also participated in the project studying interstate variation in surgery rates among patients with low back and knee injuries. Her previous work at WCRI includes the analysis of workers' compensation fee schedule designs. Dr. Fomenko received her Ph.D. in Economics from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
