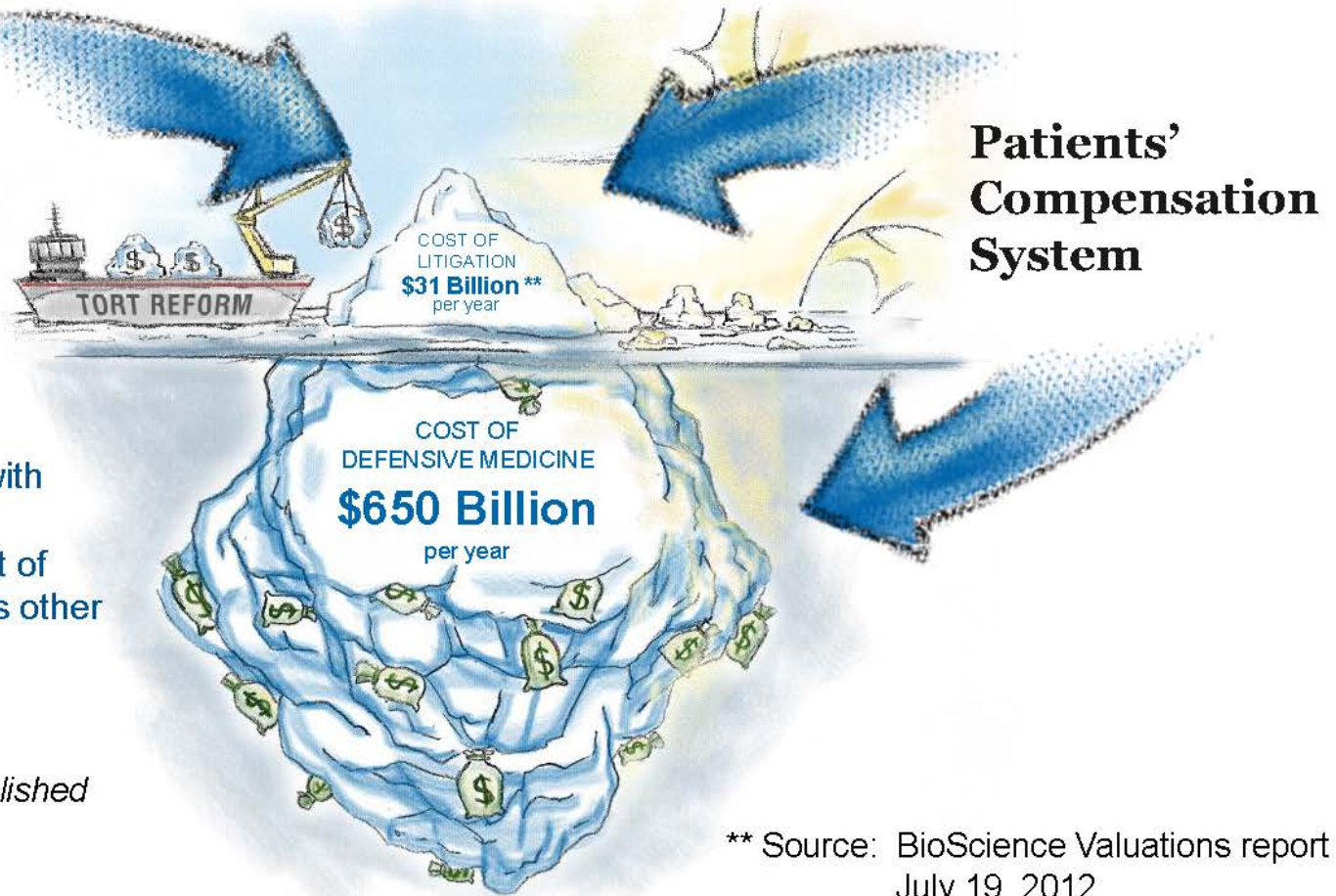


# REDUCES BOTH LITIGATION COSTS AND COST OF DEFENSIVE MEDICINE

# FLORIDA: BY THE NUMBERS



- \$43 Billion Spent Annually on Defensive Medicine (all payers)
- Economic Impact to Public Sector:
  - Medicaid: Annual Savings: \$2.3 billion; 10 year savings = \$12 billion
  - State Employees: Annual Savings: \$505 million; 10 year savings = \$3 billion
- Economic Impact to Private Sector:
  - Savings between \$31 - \$66 billion over ten years
  - Annual Savings *per Florida employee* range from \$4,124 to \$8,780
  - Annual savings on health insurance premiums between 10% - 22% of the per employee
  - Florida employers could create additional 47,306 to 100,717 workers with premium savings
